An adjacent piece of land, available for sale to the north, could expand the property to more than six acres.

Perhaps the most distinct feature of the home is a special building called "Chapel Knoll." Conceived by the former owner, the late Mary Carter Crowley, the chapel was built across a small bridge on the back of the property, hidden in a dense forest-like setting.

The main residence, built in 1935 and featuring more than 6,700 square feet of living space was updated in the mid 1970s by Mrs. Crowley and her husband, David. Walls were knocked out to add space, including creating a larger family room and breakfast room and adding an office that overlooks the

back yard and woods.

Well-proportioned rooms include a spacious living room and den, a kitchen with a large center island and a master suite with one of three fireplaces. A separate guesthouse features a bedroom, bath and kitchen.
